Motorists Note: Third Wave of Smooth Operator Begins August 1st

PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY, VIRGINIA . . . Aggressive drivers, beware! The eyes of the Prince William County Police Department are watching you. The third wave of the Smooth Operator aggressive driving campaign begins on Sunday, Aug. 1, 2010, and runs through Saturday, Aug. 7, 2010.

Smooth Operator is a regional anti-aggressive driving campaign that involves nearly 30 law enforcement agencies throughout the metropolitan Washington, D.C. area. Prince William County police issued 1,691 citations during the second wave of the enforcement campaign earlier this month.

Prince William County Police will target those offenses most closely associated with aggressive driving. Speeding, driving while intoxicated, reckless driving, failure to wear a seatbelt, and child safety seat violations are just a few of the categories that are targeted during the Smooth Operator campaign. There are additional officers assigned to work this campaign. That means residents can expect to see an increased officer presence on County roads.
