Williams Ordinary (circa 1765) is one of only three colonial structures within the town of Dumfries. It has been called Love's Tavern, the Stage Coach Inn and the Old Hotel. The building now houses the Prince William County Department of Public Works Historic Preservation Division. Information on area attractions is available to those who visit this architectural treasure.

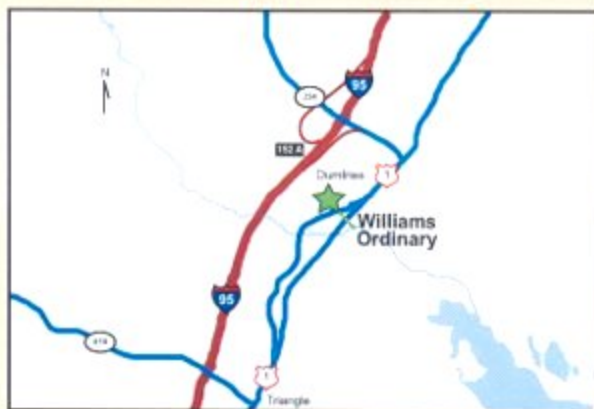
